

Urban trekking in the city center

Program

10:00 / 15:30 Guided tour of the city center following an itinerary which chronologically goes through all the history of the town from its foundation combining the official history to legends and mysteries, constellations and Templar knights, important characters like Frederick II and Celestino V, the famous Pope of the "great refusal". Starting from the Basilica of Santa Maria di Collemaggio, with the first Holy Door in the world and the only one being opened every year, you will pass across one of the city's access gates to take a photo of one of the most picturesque medieval streets in the city center. Keeping going uphill you will reach the Basilica of San Bernardino, a great example of L'Aquila baroque and the Castle located at the highest point of the city, an impressive Spanish fortress from where you can enjoy a spectacular view of the Gran Sasso of Italy. From there, passing through





charming little squares and narrow roads you will arrive in Piazza Duomo where the tour ends with a tasting of local nougat in the oldest cafe in town.
